

## Psalm 23 - Week 4: My Shepherd the Host

*Leaders- remember this is just a guide- make it feel natural and not forced. The goal is not to get through the questions but to encourage deep and thought-provoking conversation. If you only get through 1 question but the conversation was deep and pointed towards Jesus, that's great. If you read them all and the conversation was deep and pointed towards Jesus, also great. The questions are discussion starters, they are not to be viewed as a checklist.*

### Opener(s)

1. What are some of your greatest desires in life?
2. Where do you and have you sought out fulfillment in life?
3. What role does God have in those desires?

### Read Luke 11:9-13

1. What does it mean to ask, seek, knock?
2. What response do you have to these verses? Does it feel like it's missing the point or does it make you elated?
3. What does it mean that God is giving you the Holy Spirit?
4. Is the Holy Spirit a good gift? Why?

### Read Ephesians 3:13-21

1. What does it mean that God has glorious riches that he plans to give you? (hint: it's not talking about materialism)
2. What does it mean that Christ dwells in your heart?
3. What does it mean to be rooted and established in love?
4. What does it mean to be filled to the fullness of God?
5. Who is all this happening to?
6. God can do more than we can ask or imagine according to what? To whose glory?

### Read Psalm 23 (focus on verse 5&6)

1. What does an overflowing cup look like in light of all the above?
2. How does that look in your life, specifically?
3. What does it mean that God prepares the table?
4. What was David's great desire?
5. Now what is your desire?

Pray together as a group for each other.
